This Tuesday starts the 2nd Half of our Bowling Season, and another chance for the rest of us to qualify for the end of season Championship Roll-offs. Good Luck to all teams in the second half! This week will also be the first week of the Brosius Doubles Tournament. This tournament is a 2-week doubles tournament which is bowled during our normal league play. Handicaps will be used by both bowlers, but please remember the handicaps used are the current handicaps of each bowler on the first week. Handicaps will be locked and not change for week 2 of the tournament. Cost is \$10 per bowler/\$20 per doubles team, you can enter with as many partners as you would like. Please arrive a little early to allow time to sign up for this legendary tournament. As a reminder both bowlers who enter the Brosius Doubles must bowl both weeks, as this is a 2-week tournament. If your team has a rotation and it is your scheduled week off, you will be permitted to bowl on the blind team, or on adjacent lanes to our league for your scores to count towards the tournament.
