According to Elon Musk, the first human received an implant from his computer-brain interface company Neuralink over the weekend. Neuralink is one of many groups working on linking the nervous system to computers, efforts aimed at helping treat brain disorders, overcoming brain injuries and other applications. There are more than 40 brain computer interface trials underway, according to clinicaltrials.gov. Neuralink's device is about the size of a large coin and is designed to be implanted in the skull, with ultra-thin wires going directly into the brain. In its September announcement, Neuralink said the wires would be surgically placed in a region of the brain that controls movement intention. The initial goal of the so-called brain computer interface is to give people the ability to control a computer cursor or keyboard using their thoughts alone.

Bowling in the Mini-Calcutta? No I'll be on a boat with MY buddy Gary (Bybee) - What a risk taker!


Heard in the bar after bowling: Political Talk – not a good thing after 6 - 8 beverages!
