Those 4 teams will draw for their starting lane Tuesday before bowling. The Championship roll-off will be bowled on lanes 5,6,7 and 8 with the teams switching pairs after each game. The roll-off teams will be bowling for bonus roll-off money of \$850, \$650, \$450, and \$250 based on what position they finish. The team with the most total pins with handicap after the 3 games will win the Championship, Good Luck to all Teams. The teams not in the roll-off will each receive \$60 per team to do with whatever they wish at the start of bowling this week.

Thank you to all bowlers who attended the Calcutta Meeting before bowling Tuesday. I thought there was a lot of good feedback for this year's tournament. Andy Zilis and myself will start collecting money for the Calcutta this Tuesday, and we will host the draft in the lounge after bowling. As was announced Tuesday the cost to participate in the Calcutta will remain the same as last year at \$150 per bowler.
