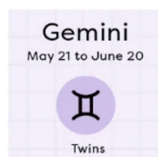

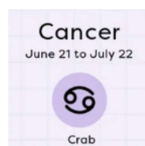


Strengths: Gentle, affectionate, curious, adaptable, ability to learn quickly and exchange ideas
