Back when \$99.95 was all it cost to paint a car. After a few years of doing that Dan found his true calling in the drapery business. He owned Prism Draperies for over 20 years. Dan sold the business when he started having serious vision problems and passed on drapery jobs to fellow member, **Gary Bybee**.
