**October 19, 2023**

October golf can be hit or miss with the weather but so far this year it has been pretty damn good. This week at Naperbrook Golf Course the weather was once again very pleasant. The golf course was in excellent shape. I listened to and spoke with many guys afterwards and there were only positive comments about the course. The general consensus was that pretty much everyone would like to see Naperbrook on the schedule again next year.

For the most part we didn't see a lot of really low scores or a lot of really high ones either. **George Les** led with a scratch 76. **Rich Schroeder** came the closest with this week's next lowest scratch score (80). **Jim Day** (81) and **Dick Kerkstra** (82) weren't far off either. **Rich Schroeder and George Les** tied for the low net score of the week with 68. **Jim Day, Jim McDermott, Arnie Carlstrom and Mike Loye** all had good days as well with net scores of 70. We can't talk scores without going to the other extreme. The high scratch score of the week was 123. That is actually one the lower high scratch scores that we have had this year.

This week wrapped up the World Series event. **Jim McDermott's** net 70 was enough for him to claim the top spot in the "A" division. **Anthony Serritella** finished two strokes back in 2<sup>nd</sup> place and **Mike Heslop** was just three strokes back rounding out the top three. In the "B" division **Lee Kaz** had a 5-stroke lead after a first round net 65 and followed that up with another solid performance in the second round to finish in 1<sup>st</sup> place ahead of **Dan Tomkins** (2<sup>nd</sup> place) and **Jim Musser** (3<sup>rd</sup> place).

There are just two dates left on the 2023 golf schedule beginning with next week's Calcutta at Bolingbrook Golf Club and then we wrap up the season on October 31<sup>st</sup> with a 10am shot gun start at Silver Lake followed by a dinner after golf.

If you would like to play in the Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> Calcutta or just want to golf that day and didn't get a chance to sign up on the bulletin board, call the hotline right away so Larry can get you on the sheet. If you haven't golfed at Bolingbrook GC before, I would definitely recommend that you get out there next week. Unfortunately I will be stuck at the firehouse and can't make it. I did get to play there today and even though it rained overnight and a little while we were playing, the course was in fantastic shape. It's a beautiful golf course with a few very interesting hole layouts. The early weather forecast for next Tuesday is partly sunny and 70 degrees. I know that there are some guys kicking their self in the ass for missing out on Naperbrook this week. Don't be one of those guys next week.

It is time to think about nominations for our next BTC officer. We will be voting for who will be next year's secretary at Silver Lake on October 31<sup>st</sup>. Just a few reminders:

1) to call the course on the day of golf if you cannot make it, if you call me, I don't listen to my messages till after golf.

2) please try to keep pace with the group in front of you. Do not look back, look forward.

If everyone tries to keep pace it makes golf more enjoyable for all

3) golf rule-ball out of bounds is out of bounds, distance, and stroke so a) hit from the spot you originally hit the shot from or option b) take the point where the ball **went** out of bounds and go laterally to the fairway no closer to the hole and take a 2-stroke penalty and hit from there.

4) A Builders tee club rule, that some don't know. If you lose a ball on the golf course, not out of bounds and you can't find it you are able to drop it where you thought it might be and take a 1 stroke penalty and **drop** a ball and hit from that spot. Might come into play more with the leaves and the rough so deep this time of year. I don't know for sure how this started but I believe it was put in to speed up play.

Don't forget to check the board at the golf course for news of the day.

Another thing, if you could call your golf group before **Friday at 5pm please**. If you call after that I will try to get you on the tee sheet but can't guarantee it. More to come on my golf news by the weekend.
