#### **BOWLING NEWS**

Our first week of Bowling is in the books, welcome back! Please note we had a couple of bowlers who while they are long time Builders Tee Members and bowled last year, they did not bowl enough games last year to qualify for an entering average and therefore there was an adjustment to their handicaps off of the sheet that I handed out this past week. This was all corrected and we should not have that issue moving forward. We are in need of a few bowlers to fill-out teams if you know of anyone interested in bowling, please call of text me at 708-912-8831.

A couple things I would like to remind everyone. I will have the USBC Sanction Cards again this week available to fill out. Most bowlers have filled them out and I thank you, as it makes it easier for me. Since our league doesn't start until November, if you are bowling in another USBC Sanctioned league this season chances are you have already paid the Sanction Fee through that league. You just have to indicate on the card you are paid through that other league. If you have not paid through another league there is a fee of \$29.00 due when you fill out and turn in your Section Card. All Builders Tee Club bowlers must be sanctioned in order to participate in our league.

This week I am going to hand out Invoices for your Team Sponsors. The fee is the same as years past and is \$125.00. This fee is due by the 6<sup>th</sup> week of bowling, if you have any questions or concerns about this please come see me during bowling. I am working on our 2023-2024 prize list and will have a couple different versions available within the next couple of weeks. I will provide these to all team captains, at which time we will have a vote on which one the members prefer.

As for the rules which were revised and updated at our bowling meeting before bowling last week. There were two changes of note I would like to point out. We had decided to bowl the first 3 weeks as just one division, and then after the first 3 weeks we will split the league into our usual "A" and "B" divisions. The divisions will be divided by the total pins plus handicap with the top 6 teams going into the "A" division and the bottom 6 teams going into the "B" division. The other rule change is that we no longer have the 15-pin drop rule. Which means after 9 games bowled this year you will receive your "true" or actual average and the corresponding handicap. In addition, we added a 10-pin drop rule for all new bowlers to the Builders Tee Club, which will remain in effect all season, I am currently trying to see if the computer system will monitor this, or it will have to be done manually each week by me.

Finally, we have quite a few members returning to bowling after taking some time off, as well as, members new to the Builders Tee Bowling League please help me to make them feel welcome. We still have a few weeks according to our rules to welcome more bowlers, so as always if you know anyone interested in bowling please call or text me at 708-912-8831.
