Many of you have heard by now that **Bob Vizdal's youngest (34 yrs old) daughter Steffani (Vizdal) Hommes** was in a terrible car accident this past Friday. She was driving on Governors Hwy near Peotone when a teenager tried to make a u-turn in front of her which resulted in a high-speed head-on collision. Among her many injuries Steffani suffered a torn carotid artery which resulted in a massive stroke. After being transferred to Christ Hospital, surgeons performed a Craniectomy. They had to remove a portion of her skull to relieve swelling and pressure on the brain. There has been significant damage to the brain. Steffani remains at Christ Hospital in critical condition in the Neurology ICU. I can't imagine how difficult it must be for Bob and his wife Ginny as parents to know that the only thing they can do is hold Steffani's hand and pray for a miracle. What we can do for our friend is offer our love, support and prayers.
